## Site Features

### Persons

Immediate access to over 280,000 senior government decision makers and advisors. Results include name, title, address, phone, fax, email.

Coverage includes three branches of government at the Federal, State, Municipal (over 5,000 population), and County levels.

### Announcements

For the year 2017 news descriptors are presented for all significant appointments and nominations at the Federal, State and local levels. Over 400 sources are reviewed daily. Announcements are searchable by last name, department/agency.

### Plum Positions

These graphics appear beside the names of individuals as appropriate. They represent those selected by Presidential appointment and U.S. Senate confirmation (1,217 positions) or by Presidential appointment without U.S. Senate confirmation (364 positions). News announcement notes of same are presented as backgrounders for each.

### Offices

Six ways to quickly search an office or position (including by abbreviation). Individual results are presented within a hierarchal structure for context. Personnel within an office are shown along with activities thereof by the symbol **i**. Offices are linked vertically to as many as 12 levels.

### GovSense

This is a proprietary system presenting multiple variations of titles for similar functions. Select all or specify choices from 26 Information Technology titles, 19 Emergency titles, 5 Program titles, and 15 Purchasing titles. Your selection is searchable by position, title and office.

### Office Activities

A symbol **i** beside an office indicates that further information is available for the activities of that office. Included are Contracts, Employment, Expenditures, Fiscal Year Spending, IT Business Cases and Portfolios, Strategic Plans, Mission Statements, Charts for appropriate levels and units.

### Organization Charts

Two types of charts are presented, the traditional pre-published inverted tree-shape and current dynamic charts in tree or vertical patterns.

Over 700 pdf charts, published quarterly, linking parents and subsidiary offices to a 9-level depth.

Dynamic, or current, charts are infinite for the Federal, State and large municipal offices. They are color coded to show position within office hierarchies.

### Military Facilities

These are presented by service, branch and geographic location. Joint base commands and tenant units are shown. All are linked to parent organizations.

## More Site Features...

### **Research and Development Descriptive Summaries**

Currently RDDS (formerly PEDs), describe Department of Defense activity, presented by title, program element number, project, and mission descriptions.

### **Federal Contracts**

These may be searched by fiscal year, category, funding office, keyword or vendor. Results show dollar amounts, key dates, parent/child relationships and total annual expenditures by vendor and office. Active Contracts can be further searched by display options such as small business, woman owned, veteran owned, etc.

### **Information Technology**

More than 8,000 federal IT Portfolios and IT Business Cases are presented by federal agency and uniquely searchable. These give the greatest insight into IT investments for each agency including an understanding on the development of new capabilities and the support of operations and maintenance.

### **Government Locator**

With nearly 40,000 governments, many with similar names, find quick access to State, Municipal or County entity by name, location or population.

### **Expenditures and Employment**

Current fiscal year Federal budgets and employee numbers are shown by department, agency and offices (where available).

At the State, Municipal and County levels, Federal Bureau of Census expenditures and employees are presented by

45 spending categories for each. Employment numbers are current. Expenditures numbers are older and caution should be used other than as broad spending indicators.

### **Supported Facilities**

These are 340,000 organizations outside of the government structure that rely on government financial support. Personnel names and offices are not included. Searchable by 34 categories, geographically and keyword.

### **Vendors**

Over 200 traditional pdf organization charts are presented for the top 100 Federal vendors, ranked by dollar volume. These are searchable for personnel, positions, offices and contracts (see Federal Contracts).

### **MyGov**

This selection allows users to select and save multiple searches particular to their interest. They are identically researchable at later dates to determine changes in personnel or offices.

For Federal Contracts user may plan a specific notice date to be advised of an expiring or new contract. Selections may be made by spending categories, funding, vendor (parent or subsidiary), office or keyword.

### **Unlimited downloads**

There are no restrictions for user downloads to client systems for charts, contacts, offices or other searches. User may import to spreadsheet or internal database systems to facilitate alternative usage as needed.
